

## City of Chapman, Kansas



The city of Chapman, Kansas has a population of 1290. It is defined as A Third Class City in Kansas. It has a Mayor and 5 Council Members and all are elected for four-year terms. These terms are staggered so that every 2 years, 3 council members are elected. Then in another 2 years, the mayor and 2 council members are elected.

Chapman City Council holds two meetings every month on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays at 7:00 p.m. at the Golf Course. Council Members take their official oath of office in May of the year they were elected. At that meeting, they are sworn in and the Mayor appoints each council member to serve on several committees.

These Committees include each of the Departments of the City: Police; City Office (Budget & Audit); Electric Light; Water and Sewer; Streets and Parks; and, Golf Course.

The City has many other committees that are served by Volunteers. These committees are Library; Recreation; Public Housing; Zoning Planning; Zoning Appeals; Tree; ADA; Pool; and, Economic Development. Council Members are asked to attend these committee meetings and work with the committees as a liaison between Council and the committees.

The City has many responsibilities and maintains many areas. Some of these include Swimming Pool; Ball Complex; City Park; Tennis Court and Basketball Area. There are approximately 6 1/2 miles of streets and 700 water and electric meters. The golf course has a clubhouse and 5 golf cart storage areas and 15 rental carts.

One of the accomplishments of the Chapman Economic Development Committee has been a pamphlet of the City. It is available to you and be sure to request one if you would like one. Our annual celebration is Labor Day, and there are many activities, including a parade. Other city activities include the Indian Hill Golf Course (9-holes), with cart rental and a summer youth program. The City Pool opens on Memorial Day and closes at the end of August. There is youth winter basketball and a spring track meet. The Chapman Public Library is open Tuesday, Wednesday evening, Thursday, and in the morning on Saturday. The Chapman Senior Center is open daily and the Chapman Public Housing Authority has elderly and low-income housing.

The City Park is located on East 2nd Street, and has picnic tables and play ground equipment. The Chapman Sports Complex is located on East 6th Street. It features a tennis court and basketball goals.
